Rebecca House Hospice	Rebecca House is the children's hospice on the Isle of Man, they offer much needed respite & end of life care.
St Pancras Hospital	We are the rapid response team at St Pancras Hospital. Our therapist go out into the community and visit patients to prevent hospital admission.
Jack and Jill community playgroup	It's a charity run playgroup that's just about keeping its head above water. Working in a disadvantaged area in Derry in Northern Ireland it helps provide a much needed playgroup facility for children aged 3-4.
Jigsaw Trust	Jigsaw, is a school for pupils with Autism Spectrum Disorder.
The sick children's trust	Crawford house in Newcastle provides free family accommodation for the families of seriously ill children.
Stripey Stork	Stripey Stork is a new charitable organisation run by four Mums that collects pre-loved baby items (clothes, equipment, furniture and toys) and distributes them to local families in need in the Reigate & Banstead Borough.
